



Thanks again for your interest our research activities. If you wish to join the IEE as a visiting or associated researcher, you can do so by formally applying to visit the Institute over a given period.

The only eligibility conditions are that you can confirm your status as a researcher – be it an early, mid or late stage one; and that the research project that brings you to Brussels has both an interdisciplinary dimension and is clearly within the scope of European studies.

- Disciplinary Applications or researchers not focusing on the EU are invited to send their applications for Visiting Researcher status directly to the [Research Centre](#) of interest.
- A visiting researcher is always affiliated to one of the Institute's constituent research teams through which they are given a primary contact person, often the academic supervisor. We advise you to contact the supervisor of your choice among the IEE-ULB [academic staff](#).
- Visiting researchers are expected to fully integrate and participate in the IEE-ULB's research activities and to animate at least one research seminar outlining the most original aspects of their research. The work needs to address one of our [research themes](#).

To submit an application as a “Visiting Researcher” with an interdisciplinary project please write to research.iee@ulb.ac.be. Applications are reviewed by the IEE authorities within 2 weeks following submission

An administrative fee of 32 € are expected to register for the university as a visiting researcher.

Multiple shared workspaces are available to visiting researchers at the IEE-ULB as well as library access. The IEE-ULB cannot warrant access to an office or personal computer. If a visiting or associated researcher wishes to apply for a private office, the request needs to be made at the moment of the general application and it will be evaluated by the IEE-ULB's authorities.
